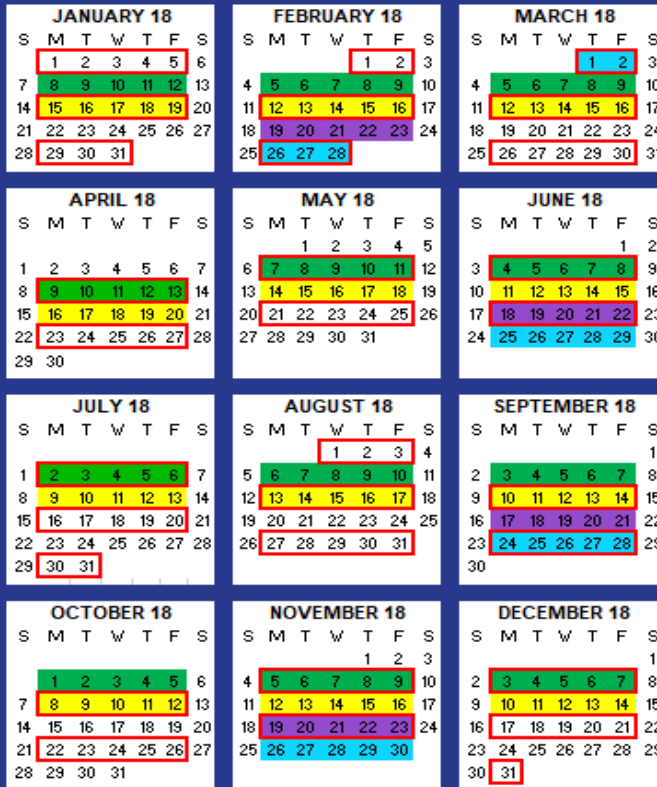

Recycling

- ✗ No lids, plastic bags or bin liners.
- ✗ No general waste or garden waste.
- ✗ No nappies or medical waste.
- ✗ No foam or polystyrene.
- ✗ No kitty litter, manure or animal droppings.

- ✓ Flatten cardboard boxes.
- ✓ Empty bottles and containers.
- ✓ Wash out containers.

Green Waste

- Green waste needs to be placed on a tarp, in an open rigid container or tied in bundles.
- DO NOT put it in plastic bags or cardboard boxes as it will not be collected.
- Less than 1.5 metres in length.
- No thicker than 20 cm in diameter.
- 2 cubic metres maximum.

Hard Waste

- Less than 1.5 metres in length.
- 2 cubic metres maximum.
- Easily lifted by two people.

Items that will not be collected:

- ✗ Fridges and freezers.
- ✗ Hazardous materials (e.g. tyres, batteries or asbestos).
- ✗ Broken glass or building rubble.
- ✗ Car bodies or engine blocks.
- ✗ Chemicals or liquids (e.g. paints and oils).
- ✗ Normal household rubbish or gas bottles.

Green and Hard Waste should be placed out on the weekend prior to your collection week.

Littering fines can be enforced for any items that are placed out earlier than permitted.
