



# No Spray Register Application Form 2022-2024

**Applications must be submitted to Council by**

**Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> August 2022**

As part of the maintenance of roadside vegetation, Sorell Council undertakes a spraying program within both urban and rural areas of Sorell, using Government approved chemicals. As part of the program, Council invites residents to apply for their property frontage to be added to the No Spray Register for the 2022-2024 period. Current permit holders from the 2020-2022 period can re-apply by confirmation email to [sorell.council@sorell.tas.gov.au](mailto:sorell.council@sorell.tas.gov.au) as permits have expired on 30 June 2022. If your application is approved, you must undertake control of the vegetation along the frontage of your property in accordance with Council's No Spray Register Policy. **No Spray Application Agreement**

In making this application, I hereby acknowledge that should my application be approved, I will be responsible for the maintenance of the vegetation along the road frontage of my property in accordance with the permit, and that failure to do so is likely to result in Council cancelling the No Spray Permit and resuming chemical spraying of the vegetation. I also acknowledge that any permit issued will only be for a maximum two (2) year period and that I will be required to make a further request should I wish to have the No Spray Permit extended beyond that date. As per Council procedure, I am responsible for replacement of stolen or damaged markers after Council’s initial installation of makers.
