Registration Fees

Working Dog which is kept for the purpose of working farm stock.	\$33.00

A concession rate applies only to ONE dog per owner and as such a Pension Concession Card or Health Care Card will not be applied until it is sighted at the time of payment.

Terms and Conditions of Registration

- 🐾 A child under the age of 16 is to register their pet in the name of a parent or guardian.
 - 🐾 Current and valid concession cards must be produced when making the payment to receive the concession rate.
 - 🐾 Sterilisation certificate must be provided for new registration of desexed dogs.
 - 🐾 Dogs 6 months and over must be registered and microchipped.
 - 🐾 Breeders must produce a current stud prefix issued by the TCA.
 - 🐾 In the case of working dogs, a demonstration may be required.
 - 🐾 Owners of greyhounds must produce written evidence and for concession.
 - 🐾 If you have changed municipalities, you can transfer the registration of your dog free of charge. You will need to produce evidence of the current registration or produce the current tag.
 - 🐾 Evidence of microchipping must be provided at time of registration.
 - 🐾 Guide dogs and assistance dogs are free of charge with evidence at time of registration.
 - 🐾 A maximum of two dogs can be registered at a property. Three or more dogs will require an application for a kennel licence.
- The owner of a dog must notify Council in writing within 14 days of:
- 🐾 The dog's death, loss or removal or
 - 🐾 The transfer of the dog to another municipal area.
